Thank you for sharing the Applicant's response letter.

Following a further internal review, I can confirm that Network Rail no longer objects to planning application 62A/2023/0026. I will be sending a more detailed letter to this effect by the end of this week.

Network Rail still has aspirations to close Fullers End level crossing in the future and therefore we welcome that the proposed schemes' indicative design and layout does not prohibit the possibility of a future diversionary route for the public right of way.
