Converter Academy Orders

Points raised in relation to school conversion.

Project: Acklam Whin Primary School, Middlesbrough to convert and join The Legacy Learning Trust.

AB key points raised:

- Acklam Whin is an Ofsted 'Good' school.
- This proposal is in line with the Department for Education's published Trust Development Statement for Middlesbrough.
- Acklam Whin has already established effective partnerships with the other primary schools in The Legacy Learning Trust (TLLT) and has been working with TLLT on school improvement for several months.
- TLLT is a local trust of currently six schools (five primary and one secondary).
- The Board sought assurances around the trust's future growth plans.
- The Board sought assurances around trust finances and supported the SRMA deployment.

RD decision: Approve with conditions - provision of the trust's financial plan following the SRMA report.

Points raised in relation to significant changes application.

Project: Framwellgate School, Durham to increase capacity.

AB key points raised:

- Framwellgate School has secured a full new build under the Government School Rebuilding Programme 2022.
- Durham Local Authority requested an increase in site capacity of 300 places to recognise the building of new homes in the area.
- The board were informed of strong support for this proposal, following stakeholder consultation in 2023.
- Students will be admitted gradually with numbers increasing over subsequent years.
- The board members considered the details of the project and supported the proposed recommendation.
