



## Teacher (Degree) Apprenticeship (TDA) secondary mathematics funding pilot: application criteria

We'll not consider any answer which exceeds the word limit for a particular question.

We'll score each question out of 5. Question 2 is double weighted. This means we'll double the score for this question, for example, if we score you 3 we'll double that to 6.

If you score 2 or less on any question, we'll automatically remove your submission from the process. This means we'll not consider you for the pilot scheme.

The total score available is 35.

Excellent	5 (pass)	<p>A comprehensive response that:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• answers the question in full</li><li>• addresses the key points</li><li>• provides evidence to demonstrate that the provider has the knowledge, experience, capability, resources and capacity to meet or exceed the requirement</li><li>• demonstrates an excellent understanding and high-level of confidence with no concerns or omissions identified</li></ul>
Good	4 (pass)	<p>A good response that:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• answers the question</li><li>• addresses the key points</li><li>• provides evidence to demonstrate that the provider has the knowledge, experience, capability, resources and capacity to meet the requirement</li><li>• demonstrates a good understanding and level of confidence</li><li>• may include some minor concerns or omissions but are not considered to present a risk or have an impact on service delivery</li></ul>

Minor omissions	3 (pass)	<p>The response:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• answers the question but may not have fully addressed the key points</li> <li>• may not have provided enough evidence to fully demonstrate that the provider has the knowledge, experience, capability, resources or capacity to meet the requirement</li> <li>• demonstrates a satisfactory understanding and level of confidence</li> <li>• may include some concerns or omissions that present an element of risk or may have an impact on service delivery, but can be reasonably managed or resolved</li> </ul>
Major omissions	2 (fail)	<p>The response:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• does not answer the question in full</li> <li>• fails to address all the key points</li> <li>• fails to provide relevant evidence to demonstrate that the provider has the knowledge, experience, capability, resources or capacity to meet the requirement</li> <li>• demonstrates a lack of understanding or confidence</li> <li>• includes concerns or omissions that present a risk or would have an impact on service delivery and would require significant intervention to manage or resolve</li> </ul>
Unacceptable	1 (fail)	<p>The response:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• fails to answer the question</li> <li>• does not address the key points</li> <li>• does not provide evidence to demonstrate that the provider has the required knowledge, experience, capability, resources or capacity and the provider is unlikely to meet the requirement</li> <li>• demonstrates a lack of understanding or confidence</li> <li>• includes significant concerns or omissions that represent an unacceptable level of risk or would have a detrimental impact on service delivery</li> </ul>
