# JUDGMENT

The unanimous judgment of the Employment Tribunal is as follows:

- 1. The claims of:
  - (a) breach of contract/wrongful dismissal relating to unpaid notice pay;
  - (b) payment in lieu of holiday pay
  - (c) unauthorised deductions of arrears of pay are withdrawn by the Claimant.
- 2. The claim of direct discrimination on the ground of disability is not well founded and so it fails.
- 3. The claim of victimisation on the ground of having done a protected act is not well founded and it fails.
