JUDGMENT

This has been a remote hearing which has been consented to by the parties. The form of remote hearing was by a video hearing through HM Courts & Tribunal Service Cloud Video Platform. A face-to-face hearing was not held because the relevant matters could be determined in this remote hearing.

Upon hearing the representatives for the respondent, the claimant and the claimant's representative, BY CONSENT the respondent's application to set aside the Judgment made by Employment Judge Holmes on 6 April 2023, pursuant to Rule 21 of the Employment Tribunals Rules of Procedure, Schedule 1 of the Employment Tribunals (Constitution & Rules of Procedure) Regulations 2013, is granted.

The Judgment made pursuant to Rule 21 is hereby set aside.

REASONS

- 1. The above decision was made on the basis that, following discussions at the hearing, the claimant and the respondent had agreed a settlement.
- 2. If the parties do not fulfil their obligations under the settlement made between them, then the case shall be relisted before me (if possible) for a final determination.

3. In the interim the case is stayed for 3 months. If the dispute is resolved, then the parties are to advise the Tribunal and the case will be dismissed in due course. If matters are not resolved within this timescale, then either, or both parties, are to write to the Tribunal and the case will be set down for a judicial resolution.
