JUDGMENT

- 1. The complaint that the claimant was unfairly dismissed is struck out.
- 2. The complaint that the respondent failed to pay the claimant a redundancy payment is struck out.

REASONS

- 1. The claimant complains of unfair dismissal and the respondent's failure to make a redundancy payment.
- 2. Sections 108 and 155 of the Employment Rights Act 1996 require a claimant to have not less than two years' service to make these complaints.
- 3. The claimant was employed by the respondent for less than two years.
- 4. Therefore the claimant is not entitled to bring such complaints.
- 5. The claimant has failed to give an acceptable reason, despite being given the opportunity to do so, why the complaint should not be struck out.
- 6. Accordingly, the complaints are struck out. The claimant's other complaints are not affected by this judgment.
