REMEDY JUDGMENT

- 1. The Respondent is ordered to pay the Claimant £2,851.04 for loss of income, pension loss and holiday pay.
- 2. The interest on these financial losses has been calculated, from the mid-point between the date of the discriminatory act and the date of the remedy hearing, at a rate of 8%, as being £171.22. The Respondent is ordered to pay this amount to the Claimant.
- 3. The figures above are gross figures. The Respondent is to pay the tax and national insurance owed on these amounts to HMRC directly and pay the remaining net amount to the Claimant.
- 4. The Respondent is also ordered to pay the Claimant £14,000 for injury to feeling.
- 5. The interest on the injury to feeling has been calculated from the date of the discriminatory act to the date of the remedy hearing, at a rate of 8%, as being £1,681.53. The Respondent is ordered to pay this to the Claimant.
