 - I, the undersigned, certify that the birds comprising the origin meet the following requirements:
 - a) testing has been conducted on the establishment of origin as requir by the GB Poultry Health Scheme or the Northern Ireland Poultry Health Assurance Scheme and the Salmonella National Control Plan (NCP);
 - b) the establishment of origin has not been subject to official health restrictions due to the occurrence of diseases that affect the species to be exported during the ninety (90) days prior to shipment;
 - c) during the thirty (30) days prior to the start of collection of eggs for reason of export there has been no clinical cases of the following diseases have been detected: Gumboro disease (for all species); avian infectious laryngotracheitis and turkey rhinotracheitis (for galliformes); and West Nile fever (for Anseriformes);

- d) the establishment of origin has had no clinical cases of avian infectious bronchitis were detected during the fifty (50) days prior to the start of egg collection for the reason of export;
- e) at the time of sampling for avian influenza and Newcastle disease, the flock was free from any evidence of these diseases;
- f) * the establishment of origin and parent flock from which duck hatching eggs and day-old ducks originate has not recorded cases of Duck Viral Hepatitis in the last six (6) months prior to the collection of eggs for the purpose of export;
- g) * in the case of galliformes and turkeys, the establishment of origin is free from Mycoplasma synoviae on the basis of regular monitoring with negative results;
- h) * in the case of ducks, the establishment of origin is free from Salmonella enteritidis and S.typhimurium, having been regularly tested for under a programme following a protocol similar to the Salmonella National Control Plan (NCP), with consistently negative results.
