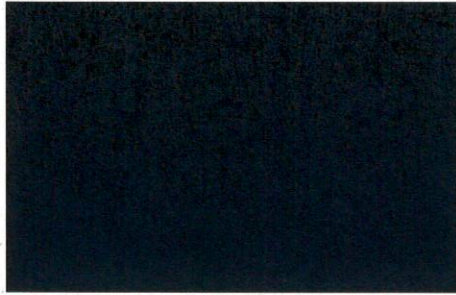

Release of Information

Thank you for your correspondence of 20 November 2020 in which you requested the following information:

'I am asking if the Royal Navy's Carrier Strike Group and Littoral Strike Group have corresponding Executive Warrant Officers (EWOs) or Senior Enlisted Leaders or the Royal Navy's corresponding term for both groups?

I do not refer to the EWO of the aircraft carriers HMS Queen Elizabeth and HMS Prince of Wales or the EWO of HMS Albion and HMS Bulwark but a senior EWO or corresponding term on the staff of the commanders of both groups.'

Your enquiry has been considered to be a request for information in accordance with the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

A search for the information has been completed within the Ministry of Defence and I can confirm that information in scope of your request is held.

In response to your request, I can advise that the Carrier Strike Group (CSG) has one Royal Navy Warrant Officer Class 1 who acts as CSG Executive Warrant Officer (EWO) however this is not their primary role. Within the Littoral Strike Group, the senior Warrant Officer is referred to as the Staff Sergeant Major (NATO Rank OR8) and is a Royal Marine.
