4. MENTAL HEALTH IN EDUCATION SETTINGS

- 4.1 The Board was provided with an update on the departmental and crossgovernment work to understand mental health among children and young people (CYP) in education settings.
- 4.2 Board members discussed the prevalence of mental health problems in CYP and noted the work of some Higher Education Institutions on early identification of mental health issues in a student's journey.

4.3 Board members discussed the complexity of this issue and encouraged crossgovernment working to identify the causes of mental health issues of CYP in education settings.

5. ADVANCED BRITISH STANDARD (ABS)

- 5.1 The Board was provided with an overview of the reforms expected as part of the ABS in England.
- 5.2 Board members discussed the implementation timeline for the ABS and the impact on the qualifications framework for 16-18 year-olds.

- 6.2 Board members discussed the importance of effective data collection and the variety of ways to measure the value of a degree's outcome.
