JUDGMENT

Employment Tribunals Rules of Procedure 2013 – Rule 21

- 1. The claim was issued in the Wales Employment Tribunals on 16 November 2023. The respondent has failed to present a valid response on time. The Employment Judge has decided that a determination can properly be made of the claim, or part of it, in accordance with rule 21 of the Rules of Procedure.
- 2. The respondent has made unauthorised deductions from the claimant's wages and must pay the claimant £460.00 gross.
- 3. The claimant was dismissed in breach of contract in respect of notice and the respondent must pay damages to the claimant of £460.00.
- 4. The claimant was dismissed by reason of redundancy and is entitled to a redundancy payment of £1380.00.
- 5. The respondent has failed to pay the claimant's holiday entitlement and must pay the claimant £736.00.

The claimant is responsible for any tax and employee national insurance due.

6. The hearing listed on **27 February 2024** is cancelled.
