Objection of neighbour.

I am once more objecting to the proposal dated 22nd February 2024 ref UTT/24/0103/PINS for the following reasons:

1. The building of holiday and dwellings would take place on green land.
2. The idea behind holiday homes is to transfer it to permanent housing.
3. The access to Mill Lane , a single lane path, is not safe for more traffic. It is very risky as it is now, without a pavement and with the number of large trucks coming through.
- 4.As mentioned before: the entrance created on the bridle path coming out onto Home Pastures with the purpose of gaining access with a bike or vehicle is dangerous as cars having to reverse out of Home Pastures no.4 and 5 could collide.
5. The bridle path belongs to Essex Highways, so it is illegal to cross.
