South Yorkshire and South Humberside

Significant Change

- To discuss Wharnccliffe Side Primary School, Sheffield to expand it's Indicated Admissions Number (IAN) from 150 to 210 pupils, due to new development/homes built in the area.
- To discuss Norfolk Community Primary School, Sheffield converting a large unused room in the main school building to create a 10 place Integrated Resource.
- To discuss Phillimore Community Primary School, Sheffield converting an existing space in the main school building to create a 10 place Integrated Resource, including a small extension which will enable the creation of a sensory/break out space.
- To discuss Wybourn Community Primary and Nursery School, Sheffield converting a large room in the main school building to create a 12 place Integrated Resource.
- To discuss Manor Lodge Community Primary and Nursery School, Sheffield extending the existing school building to create two additional classrooms, WC

provision, storage, breakout area and plant room, to accommodate up to 60 pupils. The extension will be within the main school boundary but separate to the main school building, situated at the rear of the existing school building.
