### **DECISION ON CLAIMANT'S APPLICATION FOR RECONSIDERATION**

The Claimant's application for reconsideration of the Tribunal's judgment dismissing his unfair dismissal claim is refused.

### **REASONS**

1. By email dated 19 January 2024, the Claimant applies to the Tribunal to reconsider its judgment dismissing his complaint of unfair dismissal.
2. Rule 70 of its Rules of Procedure provides the Tribunal with the power to reconsider its judgments where it is 'necessary in the interests of justice' to do so.

3. Having considered the matters which the Claimant identifies in his application email, the Tribunal does not consider that they demonstrate that reconsideration of the judgment would be necessary in the interests of justice. The matters identified by the Claimant were either in evidence at the hearing, or are matters that could have been raised, and/or are of incidental relevance to the Tribunal's determination.
  
4. In the circumstances, it is not necessary in the interests of justice to permit the hearing to be reopened at this stage. The Tribunal would further observe that there is a strong interest in finality in proceedings.
  
5. The application is accordingly refused.
