JUDGMENT

- 1. The Respondent unreasonably failed to comply with the ACAS Code of Practice on Disciplinary and Grievance Procedures 2015 and it is just and equitable to increase the compensatory award payable to the Claimant by 10% in accordance with s 207A Trade Union & Labour Relations (Consolidation) Act 1992.
- 2. The Respondent shall pay the Claimant the following sums:
 - (a) A basic award of **£1,177.88**.
 - (b) A compensatory award of £19,938.60.

Note that these are actual the sums payable to the Claimant after the above uplift has been applied.

3. The total sum awarded to the Claimant is therefore **£21,116.48** (gross).
