Thank you for your information request, dated 21 December 2022 where you asked for the following information:

This PAR is currently being prepared and will be published in the next 60 working days. We consider that your request is covered by section 22 of the Freedom of Information Act (information intended for future publication) and the information you have asked for is therefore exempt from disclosure.

Section 22 is a qualified exemption which means we have considered whether there is a greater public interest in releasing the information requested or withholding it. We recognise there is strong interest in seeing this data and accept it should not be withheld. We believe that the public interest will be best served by accompanying the publication of the data with an analysis to aid its interpretation which is currently under preparation.

If you disagree with how we have interpreted the Freedom of Information Act 2000 with regards to your request, you can ask for the decision to be reviewed. The review will be carried out by a senior member of the Agency who was not involved with the original decision.

If you were to remain dissatisfied with the outcome of the internal review, you would have the right to apply directly to the Information Commissioner for a decision.
