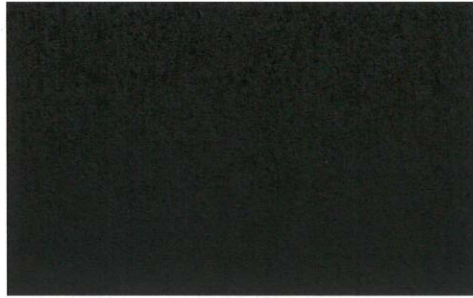

- What is the status of that trial?

- If so, in what time frame is that full roll-out expected to be completed?
- Furthermore, are vegan menus being offered at all Royal Navy land bases/ports/training centres, as well as on ships?

Q1. What is the status of that trial?

The trial is now complete.

Q2. Is a full rollout of vegan menus now being implemented across the fleet?

The 6-week menu was made available to all units in May 2019.

Q3. If so, in what time frame is that full roll-out expected to be completed?

As above, the 6-week menu was made available to all units in May 2019.

Q4. Furthermore, are vegan menus being offered at all Royal Navy land bases/ports/training centres, as well as on ships?

I can confirm that vegan meals are available on request along with other dietary requirements.
