JUDGMENT

The Judgment of the Tribunal is that:

- 1. Between 28 March 2022 and 31 March 2023, the claimant was disabled under Section 6 of the Equality Act 2010.
- The tribunal does not have jurisdiction to consider the claimant's claim for breach
 of contract under Article 7a the Employment Tribunals (Extension of Jurisdiction)
 Order 1994; the claim having been submitted prior to the effective date of
 termination. Accordingly, this claim is dismissed.
- 3. The claimant's claim for victimisation is dismissed upon withdrawal by the claimant.
- 4. The claimant's claim for unauthorised deduction of wages (in relation to the May 2022 sickness payments only) is dismissed upon withdrawal by the claimant.
