(First) The Judgment of the Employment Tribunal is that, contrary to the provisions of section 13 of the Employment Rights Act 1996, the respondent made an unauthorised deduction of \pounds 1,040 from the claimant's wages in respect of payment due to the claimant for work carried out by him at the contractual rate in the month

(Second) That the respondent shall pay to the claimant the net sum of £1,040 that being a sum equivalent to the unauthorised deduction made.
