Thank you for your information request dated 21st June 2023, where you asked the following information:

“What studies have been approved in 2022 and 2023 using CPRD data. The webpage at [Approved studies using CPRD Data | CPRD](#) is incomplete and is missing months of data for 2022 and entirely missing data for 2023.”

Unfortunately, the information is exempt from release under section 22 – Information intended for future publication:

The information you have requested is due to be published by the end of the current financial year (FY 2023 – 2024). Section 22 is a qualified exemption, which means that we have considered whether the public interest in releasing the information is outweighed by the public interest in not giving the information. Currently CPRD is experiencing an issue with updating the webpage [Approved studies using CPRD Data | CPRD](#) on the cprd.com website and is working to resolve the issue.

If you are dissatisfied with the handling of your request, you have the right to ask for an internal review. Internal review requests should be submitted within two months of the date you receive this response and addressed to: info@mhra.gov.uk

Please remember to quote the reference number above in any future communications.

If you were to remain dissatisfied with the outcome of the internal review, you would have the right to apply directly to the Information Commissioner for a decision.
