I am pleased to provide you with the information requested, please see below.

For the period 01/01/2020 to 01/08/2023:

A search under the term 'Podiatry/Chiropody' yielded no results for incidents involving handpieces.

A search under the terms 'Dental power tool systems and associated devices' and 'Dental power tool system handpieces' yielded 8 results.
