The actual spend on this contract (no sub-lots) is £71K from the start date of 28/12/2021 to now – the contract duration is 2 years and 4 days.

- Is there an extension clause in the framework(s)/contract(s) and, if so, the duration of the extension?*

The contract was set up with an optional extension of up to one period of 12 months.

- Has a decision been made yet on whether the framework(s)/contract(s) are being either extended or renewed?*

The contract optional extension has been exercised (to 31/12/2023).

- Who is the senior officer (outside of procurement) responsible for this contract?*

We have applied exemptions under Section 40 (2) of the Freedom of Information Act.
