Thank you for your email of 2 August where you have asked “ *A list of organisations approved by the MHRA to import the following products on an unlicensed basis:*

- *Norma Enanthate*
- *Rotexmedica Enanthate*
- *Hikma Cypionate*
- *Hospira Cypionate*
- *Testex Prolongatum*
- *HCG Gonasi*
- *Pregnyl HCG”*

Under section 1(1)(a) of the FOIA, we do not hold the information you have asked for, as the MHRA do not provide authorisations to the importation of unlicensed medicines. The MHRA may or may not object to importation taking place.

If you disagree with how we have interpreted the Freedom of Information Act 2000 with regards to your request, you can ask for the decision to be reviewed. The review will be carried out by a senior member of the Agency who was not involved with the original decision.

If you were to remain dissatisfied with the outcome of the internal review, you would have the right to apply directly to the Information Commissioner for a decision. Please bear in mind that the Information Commissioner will not normally review our handling of your request unless you have first contacted us to conduct an internal review.
