## FOI 23/747: Pfizer vaccine supply chains

Thank you for your communication, dated 06 October 2023, in which you requested information on Pfizer vaccine supply chains.

Please find below, our responses to your queries.

1. Under FOIA request please could you confirm the exact supply chain routes, companies and all associated nodes from Pfizer and into UK hospitals and vaccine centers please?

The information we hold concerning the manufacturing, control and distribution associated with Pfizer that is not already in the public domain is exempt under Section 41 (Information given in confidence) and Section 43 (Commercial interests) of the Freedom of Information Act, in line with Heads of Medicines Agencies (HMA)/European Medicines Agency (EMA) guidance on transparency (pages 14 -15) available at: <a href="http://www.hma.eu/fileadmin/dateien/HMA">http://www.hma.eu/fileadmin/dateien/HMA</a> joint/02- HMA Strategy Annual Reports/07-Transparency/2012 03 HMA EMA Guidance 20120309 ComPersInfo.pdf.

The "House of Commons Committee of Public Accounts The rollout of the COVID-19 vaccine programme in England Eleventh Report of Session 2022–23" <a href="https://committees.parliament.uk/publications/23019/documents/168825/default/">https://committees.parliament.uk/publications/23019/documents/168825/default/</a> clarifies the role of the different organisations in England thus:

"NHS England leads on operational delivery of COVID-19 vaccinations in England and works together with the UK Health Security Agency (UKHSA) on vaccine supply, storage and distribution (prior to October 2021, Public Health England (PHE) undertook UKHSA's responsibilities in this area). Local healthcare providers—NHS hospitals, GPs and community pharmacies—administer vaccines."

2. In the USA the mRNA products are being issued as military countermeasures thus circumnavigating all usual control standards and associated regulators. Is the UK Military or MoD, MI6, or similar military entity involved (or ever has been) with the supply of mRNA products into the UK?

Regarding your query whether the UK Military or MoD, MI6, or similar military entity is involved (or ever has been) with the supply of mRNA products into the UK, again this is outside the remit of the MHRA, and we suggest you contact the organisations themselves.

We now consider this FOI request closed.
