Thank you for your email.

"Perusing your accounts for FY2021/22 I notice that £15,252,000 is paid out in dividends. Does this represent a bonuses to staff or a payment by outside investors? If the latter may I know please the names of recipients receiving sums greater than £100,000? I assume you are not a PLC"

The MHRA Annual Report and Accounts 2021/22 reports dividend payable of £15,252k for 2020/21 and £14,849k for 2021/22 in the Statement of changes in taxpayers equity. This is in line with the HM Treasury minute on page 161 of the Annual Report and Accounts, which states:

The Secretary of State for Health, being the responsible Minister for the purposes of section 4(1)(a) of the 1973 Act, has determined (with Treasury concurrence) that a further financial objective desirable of achievement by the Medicines and Healthcare products Regulatory Agency Trading Fund for the five-year period from 1 April 2018 to 31 March 2023 shall be to achieve a return, averaged over the period as a whole, of at least 3.5% in the form of a surplus on ordinary activities before interest (payable and receivable) and dividends expressed as a percentage of average capital employed. Capital employed shall consist of the capital (PDC and long-term element of loans) and Reserves.

The dividend represents this 3.5% return and is payable to the Department of Health and Social Care.
