- If the release of any of this information is prohibited on the grounds of breach
  of confidence or commercial sensitivity, I ask that you supply me with copies
  of the confidentiality agreement and remind you that information should not be
  treated as confidential if such an agreement has not been signed. If there is a
  public interest test associated with the exemption, I ask that you take into
  account the importance of transparency in how tobacco firms interact with
  regulators.



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 I understand that you are required to respond to my request within the 20 working days after you receive this letter. I would be grateful if you could confirm in writing that you have received this request.

## For the above request:

The information requested cannot be provided under the Freedom of Information Act for the following reason:

- 'Information received is exempt from release under Section 30 Investigations this exempts information if it has at any time been held by
   the authority for the purposes of any investigation which the public authority
   has a duty to conduct.
- Discloser of information should not undermine the investigation, prosecution
  or prevention of crime, or the bringing of civil or criminal proceedings by public
  bodies. The investigation and prosecution of crime involve a number of
  essential requirements. These include the need to avoid prejudicing effective
  law enforcement, the need to maintain the independence of the judicial and
  prosecution processes, and the need to preserve the criminal court as the
  sole forum for determining guilt.

Please be aware that the MHRA and Trading Standards authorities have a duty to investigate alleged offences under Part 9 of the Tobacco and Related Products Regulations 2016 (as amended).
