JUDGMENT

The unanimous decision of the employment tribunal is as follows: -

- 1. The complaint of direct discrimination because of disability is not well founded and is dismissed.
- 2. The complaint of unfavourable treatment because of something arising in consequence of disability is not well-founded and is dismissed.
- 3. The complaint of failure to make reasonable adjustments for disability is not well-founded and is dismissed.
- 4. The complaint of direct discrimination because of race is not well founded and is dismissed.
- 5. The complaint of indirect discrimination because of age is not well founded and is dismissed.
- 6. The complaint of harassment related to race is not well founded and does not succeed.
