JUDGMENT

The complaints of breach of duty of care and breach of confidentiality are struck out.

REASONS

- 1. By a letter dated **9 January 2024** the Tribunal gave the claimant an opportunity to make representations or to request a hearing, as to why the complaints of **breach of duty of care and breach of confidentiality** should not be struck out because they have no reasonable prospect of success since they are not claims that the tribunal has jurisdiction to consider.
- 2. The claimant has failed to make representations in writing, or has failed to make any sufficient representations, why this should not be done or to request a hearing. The complaint of **breach of duty of care and breach of confidentiality** is therefore struck out.
- 3. The claimant's remaining claim(s) remains listed for hearing on **18-19 March 2024**.
