

Female Offender Strategy Delivery Board Dashboard

A [web-based data visualisation tool](#) has been created to allow users to view and customise charts based on the key metrics within the Female Offender Strategy Delivery Plan (2022-25). The dashboard should be used as way to discover the data available on females within the Criminal Justice System and as a launching point for further investigation.

The Metrics Dashboard, presents 5-year data trends for each metric in the Female Offender Strategy Delivery Plan, currently spanning 2018-2022. The dashboard uses statistics to monitor changes across each priority area of the Delivery Plan. This dashboard will be updated periodically when new annual statistics are published to provide the most current data available.
