DESNZ Public Attitudes Tracker: Revision Note Winter 2023, UK

Revision March 2024

After the publication of the Winter 2023 reports, it was identified that the data labels relating to Northern Ireland and Wales were incorrectly swapped during the data production process. Therefore, we have revised some of the findings in the report and data in the published crosstabulations.

These errors are limited to the Winter 2023 findings referring to Northern Ireland and Wales and do not affect the overall findings presented in the report or in the published timeseries.
