Respondent: Oscar Mayer Limited (trading as Rowan Foods)

JUDGMENT

The complaint of disability discrimination, including indirect discrimination based on association or perception, harassment, or victimization on grounds of race or ethnic origin is struck out.

REASONS

- By a letter dated 27 February 2024 Tribunal gave the claimant an opportunity to make representations or to request a hearing, as to why the complaint of disability discrimination, including indirect discrimination based on association or perception, harassment, or victimization on grounds of race or ethnic origin should not be struck out because it the claimant had not complied with paragraph 5 of the order of the Tribunal dated 25 January 2024.
- The claimant has failed to make representations in writing, or has failed to make any sufficient representations, why this should not be done or to request a hearing. The complaint of complaint of disability discrimination, including indirect discrimination based on association or perception, harassment, or victimization on grounds of race or ethnic origin is therefore struck out.
