Release of Information

Thank you for your correspondence of 27 September 2021 in which you requested the following information:

'During training are Royal Navy Police Officers/staff provided with training in dealing with members of the public taking video or photographs and how to deal with them and law.'

Your enquiry has been considered to be a request for information in accordance with the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (the Act).

In response to your request, I can confirm that no training is given to Royal Navy (RN) Police Officers/Staff in dealing with members of the public taking videos or photographs and how to deal with them and the law.

Under section 16 (Advice and Assistance) of the Act, it may help if I explain that the RN Police have no jurisdiction over civilians so such incidents as stated in your request would become a matter for the Home Office Police Constabulary or the Ministry of Defence Police to deal with.
