JUDGMENT

- (1) The Claimant was not an employee of nor a worker engaged by the Respondent within the meaning of section 230 of the Employment Rights Act 1996 at the time material to this claim (August 2022-January 2023). Accordingly the claim for unlawful deduction from wages is dismissed.
- (2) The Respondent has not discharged the burden of showing a breach of contract on the part of the Claimant, nor any losses arising and accordingly the counterclaim is dismissed.
