# **JUDGMENT**

The Employment Judge gave Judgment as follows:

- 1. The Claimant was unfairly dismissed. The Respondent is ordered to pay to the Claimant a basic award of £7,904.00. There is no compensatory award.
- 2. The claim for a redundancy payment fails and is dismissed.
- 3. The Claimant has suffered an unlawful deduction of wages and the Respondent is

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ordered to pay to the Claimant the sum of £1,520.00.

- 4. The claim for holiday pay is withdrawn and dismissed.
- 5. The Claimant was dismissed in breach of contract in respect of notice and the Respondent is ordered to pay compensation to the Claimant in the sum of £3,338.04.
- 6. The total award that the Respondent must pay to the Claimant is £12,762.04.
