BLOOD EXAMINATIONS - PERSONNEL PROCEEDING TO CHRISTMAS ISLAND

It is noted that C.A.F.O. 81/58 para 5 requires personnel appointed or drafted to ships attached to the Grapple Squadron to be given blood examinations.

- 2. The expression "ships attached to the Grapple Squadron" is however embiguous as whilst some ships are permanently attached (H.M.S. MARVIK and H.M.S. MESSIMA) others are only temporarily attached for relatively short periods (e.g. H.M.S. SCAPECROUGH and H.M.H.Z.S. FUKAKI are temporarily attached at present).
- 3. Quite agent from the considerable difficulty involved in blood testing the errors of ships which are detected for temporary duty with the Grapple Squedron such ships spend most of their time in the Grapple Area on weather duties at sea many miles from Christmas Island.
- 4. It is recommended therefore that C.A.F.O. 81/58 pera 5 should be amended by adding the following "(this does not include ships temporarily attached to Grapple Squadron)".
