To the best of my knowledge the only natives who have come from this area and have disabilities recorded are a group of natives that I alone have examined medically.

I consider their disabilities to be congenital in origin and most likely of syphlitic origin, similar to charcot's joints and that they are in no way affected by any form of irradiation.

At my earliest convenience I will be examining these people fully and will, following their x-ray and blood tests, give you a further report on them.
