Would you please let me know if arrangements can be made for examining urine of personnel exposed to the risk of ingesting or inhaling radioactive material.

Some of those stationed at Maralinga and Edinburgh Field have to incur this hazard from time to time. Here, in the Atomic Energy Establishments, urine tests are carried out on those at risk, but these are much too elaborate and specialised for routine use in the service. is certain that the facilities exist both in Adelaide and in other centres, and could be used if required in an emergency or when considered necessary.

If you could let me have more details, including the fee payable, I shall ask the R.A.F. liaison officer to arrange a formal contract.
