I refer to your D.O. letter of the 5th February, in which you enquire concerning the arrangements made for examining urine of personnel exposed to the risks of ingesting or inhaling radioactive material.

We have been pressing the other Services and Departments to pursue these matters as quickly as possible, and the techniques have been reviewed. However, before giving any indication as to whether Adelaide or any other centre can meet the requirements that you request. I have asked the Commonwealth Department of Health (that is, X-Ray and Radium Laboratories) to give me details as soon as possible.

I will forward this information to you as soon as an accurate statement has been received.
