<p>Introduction of two new sub-regulations – There was no subregulation that captured separation requirements that affected both lateral and vertical separation and therefore RA 3228(1) was changed from Separation Standards – Lateral to become Separation Requirements. This led to the removal of the table that used to be in Standard Separation - Vertical addressing the issue of it not capturing the requirements of SVFR and also not aligning with RA 3238.</p> <p>The other new sub-regulation, RA 3228(4) contains the contents of RA 3238 which will subsequently be withdrawn. The information is presented in tabular format to make it easier to read than the current published version of RA 3238.</p> <p>RFC_2021_013 has been addressed by the insertion of paragraph 23 that recognises that reduced vertical separation should not be taken without pilot consent on military aircraft equipped with an Airborne Collision Avoidance System.</p> <p>Changes to the Increased Vertical Separation Standards for Typhoon addresses RFC_2023_137 and the deletion of Carrier Control Zones from sub-regulation (6) addresses RFC_2023_149.</p>
