Wages

1. The complaint of unauthorised deductions from wages is well-founded. The respondent made unauthorised deductions from the claimant's wages in the period **30 June 2021 until 30 September 2022**.
2. The respondent shall pay the claimant **£4,104.95** which is the gross sum deducted. The claimant is responsible for the payment of any tax or National Insurance.
