

THE OFFSHORE COMBUSTION INSTALLATIONS (POLLUTION PREVENTION AND CONTROL) REGULATIONS 2013 (AS AMENDED) ("THE OFFSHORE (PPC) REGULATIONS 2013")

APPLICATION NOTICE

In accordance with the requirements of the Offshore Combustion Installations (Pollution Prevention and Control) Regulations 2013 (as amended), Shell UK Limited has applied to the Secretary of State for Energy Security and Net Zero for a permit to operate a combustion installation at the Penguins Floating Production Storage and Offloading (FPSO) Installation in Block 211/13, Reference PPC/113.

As required under regulation 5(1), the Secretary of State hereby gives notice of the above application. Copies of this notice, the application and supporting information can be viewed and downloaded at https://www.gov.uk/guidance/oil-and-gas-environmental-data#offshore-combustion-installations-pollution-prevention-and-control-regulations-2013-as-amended. The operation of the offshore combustion installation which is the subject of the application is not likely to have significant negative effects on the environment of a member state. The large combustion installation subject to the application has been assessed under the Offshore Petroleum Production and Pipelines (Assessment of Environmental Effects) Regulations 1999 (as amended) for the purposes of an application for the production consent for the redevelopment of the Penguins field. Consultation with a member state is not required before a decision in respect of the PPC application can be made.

Interested Parties have until the 14/5/2024 to make representations on the application to the Secretary of State. All representations should quote the application reference **Penguins FPSO** in **Block 211/13**, **PPC/113** and may be made by letter or email to:

application decision will be made by the Secretary of State within a reasonable time.
