JUDGMENT

Rule 37(1)(a) Employment Tribunal Rules of Procedure

The claim is struck out because it has no reasonable prospects of success.

REASONS

1. By a letter dated 29 January 2024 the Tribunal gave the claimant an opportunity to make representations or to request a hearing, as to why the claim should not be struck out, on the basis that he did not have the necessary two years' service to bring a claim of unfair dismissal and hence the claim had no reasonable prospect of success.
2. The claimant has failed to make sufficient representations as to why this should not be done or to request a hearing. The claim is therefore struck out.
3. The hearing on 5 and 9 August 2024 will not now take place.
