Introduction to the C-LEO Team

Who are we?

- The UK Space Agency has set up a specific C-LEO team to deliver this funding programme.
- The C-LEO team works in close partnership with the UKSA Telecoms team to ensure C-LEO remains aligned to the broader telecoms work.

What is C-LEO?



- Connectivity in Low Earth Orbit C-LEO (seelee-oh)
- Aimed at developing technologies for building the next generation of satellite constellations and bringing them to market.
- The C-LEO programme is strongly aligned with three of the four core pillars of the National Space Strategy





Targeted Technologies

- Innovative satellite communication technology in five technology areas
- Technology readiness levels (TRL) of between 4 and 6, however proposals with higher TRL will be considered.





Eligibility & Programme Design

Eligibility

- Must be a UK-based entity
- Commercial companies must have a UK registration at Companies House.
- Successful applicants must have a UK bank account
- Use of non-UK partners must either be selffunded or be funded by other ESA Delegates





Programme Design

- A single application, with two possible funding routes.
- Different funding levels for small, medium and large enterprises
- For national grant funding, the rates opposite include a 15% uplift to the subsidy ratios for collaborative projects
- Universities rates are 80% National and 100% ARTES
- Research organisations can apply for 100%

- First stage in the process
- All applicants must submit an EOI
- Summary of your project what is it you are proposing?
- Deadline is 8th May 2024 for this competition call

Describe the business opportunity that you are targeting with this proposal, including how it will support the commercialisation of technologies necessary to meet demand for high-volume constellation production.

We do not need further details at this stage, but we will expect to see the potential benefits to the UK set out in detail in any subsequent application. If you application does not support your selection here, your proposal will be rejected.
