JUDGMENT

The complaint that the claimant was entitled to be paid a statutory redundancy payment is struck out.

REASONS

- 1. The claimant claims that he was entitled to be paid a statutory redundancy payment.
- 2. Section 155 of the Employment Rights Act 1996 requires a claimant to have not less than two years' service to have a right to a redundancy payment.
- 3. The claimant was employed by the respondent for less than two years.
- 4. Therefore, the claimant is not entitled to be paid a statutory redundancy payment.
- 5. The claimant has failed to give an acceptable reason, despite being given the opportunity to do so, why the complaint should not be struck out.

Case No: 2410811/2023

6. Accordingly, the claim of entitlement to a statutory redundancy payment is struck out. The claimant's other complaints are not affected by this judgment and will proceed to the hearing listed on 4 April 2024.
