## Additional notes for completion

### 'ISO'

- means the international standard 2-letter country code for a country.

### Consignor (box I.1.)

- The name and address (street, city and region, province or state, as appropriate) of the natural or legal person dispatching the consignment. This must be located in the third country, except for the re-entry of consignments originating from Great Britain.

### Document reference No. (box I.2.)

- a unique code that enables identification and tracking of the commercial document and consignment.

### Approval or registration No. (box I.2.a.)

- In the case of the place of destination found in Great Britain, the approval or registration number can be found in the [approved/registered premises register](#).
- In the case of the place of origin in non-EU countries, the approval number can be found in the [list of establishments in non-EU countries approved to export animal products to GB](#)
- In the case of the place of origin in EU and EFTA countries, the approval number can be found in the [list of approved ABP establishments](#).

### Central competent authority (box I.3.)

- The name of the central authority in the exporting country.

### Local competent authority (box I.4.)

- If it applies, the name of the local authority in the exporting country.

### Consignee (box I.5.)

- The name and address of the natural or legal person who's receiving the consignment. This information is optional for consignments in transit through Great Britain.

### Registered Trader (box I.6.)

- The name and address of the person in Great Britain in charge of the consignment when presented to the BCP. This is the person who makes the declarations to the competent authorities either as the importer or on behalf of the importer.

For:

- Products in transit through Great Britain, the name and address are compulsory.

### Country of origin (box I.7.)

- The name and ISO code of the country where the products were produced, manufactured, and packaged

### Region of origin (box I.9.)

- If it applies, for products affected by regionalisation measures (where a clearly defined part of a territory contains an animal subpopulation with a distinct health status).
- The name and code of the approved region, zone or compartment. The codes can be found in the appropriate third country list: [EU and EFTA](#) or [non-EU](#) countries.

### Place of origin (box I.11.)

The name, address and approval, if required by the assimilated EU legislation, of the holdings or establishments from which the animals or the products come from.

### Place of destination (box I.12.)

- The name, address and approval number of the holdings or establishments of the place of destination, if applicable.
- For storage of products in transit: the name, address and approval number of the warehouse in a free zone, the customs warehouse or the ship supplier.

### Place of loading (box I.13.)

- The name of the city and category (for example, establishment, holding, port or airport) of the final place where the products are loaded before the journey to Great Britain.

If it's a:

- container, give the place where the goods board the final means of transport to Great Britain
- ferry, give the place where the truck embarked.

### Date of departure (box I.14.)

- The date when the means of transport (aeroplane, vessel, railway or road vehicle) departs.

**Means of transport – identification (box I.15.)**

For:

- Aeroplanes – the flight number
- Vessels – the ship name(s)
- Railways – train identity and wagon number
- Road transport – registration number plate with trailer number plate if it applies.
- Ferry – state the identification of the road vehicle, the registration number plate with trailer number plate if it applies, and the name of the scheduled ferry.

**Commodity code (CN code) (box I.18.)**

- Only applicable to imports

**Entry BCP (box I.23.)**

Give the name of the BCP or the BCP identification code assigned by IPAFFS, or both.

- If applicable, this means the BCP of entry into GB.

**Authorisation/license number (box II.a.)**

- If it applies, include reference number of relevant import authorisation or license.
