# **JUDGMENT**

The Judgment of the Employment Tribunal is that:-

- 1. The claimant's claim for unpaid wages in respect of one week's pay 'in hand' is well-founded and succeeds.
- 2. The claimant's claim for unpaid wages in respect of unpaid service charges is well-founded and succeeds.
- 3. The claimant's claim for unpaid wages in respect of unpaid additional 'service charges' is well-founded and succeeds.
- 4. The claimant's claim for unpaid holiday pay is well-founded and succeeds.

The Judgement of the Employment Tribunal on remedy is that:

- 1. The respondent shall pay to the claimant the total gross sum of £1083.77.
- 2. The has been calculated in the following way:
  - a. Unpaid wages 'in hand': 1 week's pay in the agreed sum of £480.77.
  - b. Unpaid wages for 'service charges' in the agreed sum of £123.00.
  - c. Unpaid wages for additional services in the agreed sum of £300.00.

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d. Unpaid holiday pay in the agreed sum of £180.00.
