## REMEDY JUDGMENT

1. The respondent must pay to the claimant the sum of $£ 65, \mathbf{1 4 2} .05$. This award has been arrived at as follows:

Harassment Related To Sex
Injury to feelings: $£ 43,750$
Interest on injury to feelings award: $£ 10,183.56$
Loss of earnings: $£ 3,349.69$
Interest on loss of earnings award: $£ 389.84$
Holiday Pay
Holiday Pay: £440.55
Total net award
£58,113.64
2. As the total award of compensation is more than $£ 30,000$ it is necessary to gross up the award. The tax free element is $£ 30,000$. Therefore the figure upon which tax needs to be paid is $£ 28,113.64$. The grossed up compensation of $£ 28,113.64$ divided by $0.8=£ 35,142.05$.
3. The total award payable to the claimant by the respondent is therefore £65,142.05 (£30,000 + £35,142.05).
4. The claimant will be required to pay any tax that is due on this sum of money.
