## JUDGMENT

1. The claimant was dismissed by reason of redundancy. The respondent is ordered to pay to the claimant a statutory redundancy payment in the sum of $£ 6,784.00$.
2. The claimant was dismissed in breach of contract by a failure by the respondent to pay to the claimant for his period of notice. The respondent is ordered to pay damages to the claimant in the sum of $£ 4,389.12$.
3. The payments ordered at paragraphs 1 and 2 above are made up as follows:
a. Statutory redundancy payment: multiplier of $16 \times$ gross weekly salary of $£ 424.00=£ 6,784.00$.
b. Unpaid notice: 12 weeks' pay x net weekly pay of $£ 365.76=£ 4,389.12$.
c. Total $\mathrm{a}+\mathrm{b}=£ 11,173.12$
