JUDGMENT

- 1. The Claimant's claims of:
 - (a) wrongful dismissal;
 - (b) dismissal where the principal reason is making a protected disclosure;
 - (c) detriments on grounds of making a protected disclosure;
 - (d) payment for accrued but untaken holiday and
 - (e) for unlawful deduction from wages

were presented out of time in circumstances it was reasonably practicable to have been presented in time.

- 2. The Claimant's claim of a failure to make reasonable adjustment as presented out of time and was not presented within such other period as the tribunal considered just and equitable.
- 3. Accordingly the tribunal has no jurisdiction to hear the claims.
