2. OFFICE FOR STANDARDS IN EDUCATION (OFSTED) UPDATE

- 2.1 The Board received an update on the Department's approach and next steps for Ofsted following the recent appointment of His Majesty's Chief Inspector (HMCI) of Education, Sir Martyn Oliver, and the findings of the coroner following the inquest into the death of Ruth Perry.
